Historic Moment for Campeltown Grammar School

It was a historic occasion in Argyll and Bute on Wednesday 14 February when secondary pupils from across Kintyre moved into the new Campeltown Grammar School.

Welcomed to their new surroundings by two pipers, pupils were gathered in the multi-purpose sports hall where Acting Head Teacher Catherine Cameron greeted them.

"Wednesday 14 February is a historic day for Campeltown Grammar school as we move into our new premises," she said. "It is also the start of a new era of high expectations in which everyone associated with the school - parents, teachers, and partners - will work together to ensure that our children and young people aspire to achieve the best they can in school and to have success and fulfilment in their lives beyond school."



The £26 million, three-storey school has capacity to cater for up to 500 pupils and will provide young people with a modern learning environment fit for the 21st century. Outside, it will also feature a 3G sports pitch, music pavilion and large car park on the site of the existing 1960s school buildings, once they are demolished.

Phase 1 of Health and Social Care Hub for Inverurie Completed

Energy Centre handed over on target date

The new Health & Social Care Hub for Inverurie, currently being built by Morrison Construction Limited on behalf of their clients, hub North Scotland & NHS Grampian, is now one step further to opening it's doors to the local community.

The first phase of the build was handed over to NHSG on target on the 15 January 2018. This is the new Energy Centre that will supply the power, heating and hot water to the whole of the Inverurie Hospital site and allow the existing boiler house to be demolished and make way for additional parking at the hospital site.

Phase two, the main building, is targeted to open on 23 July 2018 and will provide state-of-the-art care facilities for Inverurie and the surrounding areas.



Everyone thoroughly enjoyed the event with children from each class taking to the stage to speak about their favourite part of the new school and the Kirn School Choir and Highland Dancers kept everyone entertained. Also in attendance was each Head Teacher - Walter Chalmers, Ian Ford, James Wylie, Fiona Anderson, Barbara Gray and Kirsteen Macdonald were all delighted to be part of the celebrations.
